Frontier Girls Butterflies take on more advanced leadership roles within the troop, earn badges, organize and help with community service projects, and learn new skills. At the Butterfly level our goal is boost the girls' self confidence as they advance in life skills and explore the subjects that are of the most interest to them.

How the Butterflies Got Their Name

Every year, Monarch butterflies make an incredible 2500 mile journey from the eastern United States all the way to Mexico. They persevere through all obstacles, whether wind or rain, and keep their eye on their goal, not the difficulty of getting there. As girls begin the journey toward womanhood, this can be the most difficult age. We hope that like the Monarch, they will persevere through any difficulties.

Uniforms

Frontier Girls Butterflies wear the Frontier Girls uniform of a red vest with a white shirt and navy bottoms. Their level tab and ribbons are green in color and they can wear the Butterfly level pin under their membership pin on their level tab. The Butterfly Servant's Heart Award is gold and for higher awards, their gem level is emerald.



Badges and Awards at the Butterfly Level

Badges:



To earn badges, Butterflies are required to complete 6 requirements. Usually there are two starred requirements that must be completed, the first of which is usually to complete all lower level starred requirements, and then a choice of four additional optional requirements.

Awards: Full requirements for each award can be found on the website under the Awards tab in the top menu.

Servant's Heart Award

- Complete 15 hours of community service (may be earned multiple times)

Discovery Award

- Earn at least one badge from each of the nine Areas of Discovery at the Butterfly Level

Life Skills Achievement Award

- Become proficient in 30 different life skills (If one requirement is earned per month, the award can be earned before advancing to the Eagle level.)

Fruit of the Spirit Award

- Earn each of the nine character badges listed in the Frontier Girls Creed at the Butterfly level

Liberty Award

- Learn about your country by earning the following 5 badges: U.S. Constitution, Elections, Government, U.S. History, Patriotism at the Butterfly level

Outdoor Award

- Become proficient in a variety of outdoor skills

S.T.E.A.M. Award

- Gain knowledge and skills in science, technology, engineering, arts and math.

Make a Difference Award

- Organize and lead your own community service project (20-25 hours leading at least 3 people)

Leadership Award

- Show leadership skills through earning a variety of leadership oriented badges and awards.

WOW! Award

- Earn 100+ badges at the Butterfly level

Emerald Gem Award

- This is the highest award available at the Butterfly Level. You must earn the Discovery, Life Skills, Fruit of the Spirit and Liberty Award, Leadership Award and Make a Difference Award to earn your Emerald Award.
